New Business

Gloria Van Tassel was elected to the position of 1st Vice President by acclamation. Jeanne Tittle moved nominations cease for the position of treasurer. Marie Pilot was elected to the position of treasurer by acclamation.

Donna Murray reported that the CanAm on Friday, March 8 has 40 golfers. Be there by 7:30 AM as we sing the national anthems and it is a shotgun start at 8 AM. Prizes will be awarded for KPs and putts on front and back. If you have taken 10 strokes on the fairway, pick up your ball and place it at the position of the person's ball that is the one farthest away from the hole on the putting green as everyone is eligible for putt prizes. Money for lunch is \$13.00, money for prizes is \$5.00. Please try to have exact change. Next year, the CanAm will be held on March 2, 2020 which is a meeting day.
